

2009 LEMSA DMS Survey Summary for Region I

(4 of 5 counties responded)

PLANS, POLICIES, PROCEDURES

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates exceptional compliance with:

- ✓ MHOAC policies/procedures, EOC/DOC operations, System start-up, and Demobilization.

The only items that demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- (1.2.4 i.) provision of CISD for staff (69%)
- (1.3.1 b.) annual refresher training (63%).

ASSESSMENT OF IMMEDIATE MEDICAL/HEALTH NEEDS

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Notification and Activation, except:
 - (2.1.2 e) Staff Reporting Sites for Communication Failure (56%)
- ✓ Information Sources, except:
 - (2.2.1 h, i) Residents (69%) and Other Sources (31%)
- ✓ Information Elements, except:
 - (2.2.2 d, g, h) Other Medical Facilities (56%), Weather/Roads (69%) RIMS M/H (44%)
- ✓ All Data Reporting guidelines

COORDINATION OF DISASTER MEDICAL AND HEALTH RESOURCES

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Inventories, except:
 - (3.1.1 c,d,e,f,h) SNFs (50%), Med Teams (50%), non-med Teams (50%), Supply Vendors (44%), Annual Updates (44%)
- ✓ All Ambulance Contract guidelines
- ✓ Resource Tracking, except:
 - (3.4.1 i, j) Release Date/time (69%) , Disposition (69%)
 - Resource Acquisition, Allocation, Mobilization compliance between 56-69%
 - Support for out-of-area resources was only 25-50%
 - Demobilization was at 63%

COORDINATION OF PATIENT DISTRIBUTION AND MEDICAL EVACUATION

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Patient movement from Scene, except:
 - (4.1.1 d) use of personal or non-medical vehicles for transport (50%)
- ✓ Patient Transfer and Transport, except:
 - (4.1.2 a) Inter-facility agreements
 - (4.1.3 c) Notification from hospitals for independent transport arrangements (44%)
 - Evacuation guidelines compliance at 31-56%

COORDINATION WITH HOSPITAL INPATIENT AND EMERGENCY CARE PROVIDERS

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates exceptional compliance with:

- ✓ Hospital Communications, Data, Status, Plans, and Support.

The only item that demonstrates less than 75% compliance includes:

- ☐ (5.3.1 c) Temporary triage/treatment sites outside hospital (63%)

COORDINATION WITH OUT OF HOSPITAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE PROVIDERS

- The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 31-69% compliance for Coordination with out-of-hospital providers

COORDINATION OF PRE-HOSPITAL EMERGENCY SERVICES

- ✓ LEMSA reported 100% compliance with START Triage guidelines
