

2009 LEMSA DMS Survey Summary for Region II

(14 of 16 counties responded)

PLANS, POLICIES, PROCEDURES

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ MHOAC policies/procedures and EOC/DOC operations, except:
 - (1.1.1 d) Information Management Plans developed/tested (64%)
- ✓ Training and Exercises and After Action Reports, except:
 - (1.3.1 b) LEMSA personnel receive annual refresher training (50%)
 - (1.4.1 d) AAR should be reviewed for trends (73%)

Areas that demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- OA Med/Health Plans (61-75%)
- System Start-up, DOC operations, Demobilization (54-82%), except (1.2.4 i) Prepare AAR for MHOAC (48%)

ASSESSMENT OF IMMEDIATE MEDICAL/HEALTH NEEDS

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Notification and Activation, except:
 - (2.1.2 b, e) Criteria for DOC active. (70%), Comm. Failure reporting sites (71%)
- ✓ Information Sources, except:
 - (2.2.1 e, h, i) Media (68%), Residents (54%) and Other Sources (45%)
- ✓ Information Elements and Data Reporting, except:
 - (2.2.2 d) Other Medical Facilities (68%)

COORDINATION OF DISASTER MEDICAL AND HEALTH RESOURCES

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Inventories, except:
 - (3.1.1 c,d,e,f,h) SNFs (46%), Med Teams (45%), non-med Teams (68%), Supply Vendors (44%), Annual Updates (48%)
- ✓ Resource Tracking, except:
 - (3.4.1 l, j) Release Date/time (69%) , Disposition (69%)
 - Ambulance Contract language 41-54% compliance
 - Resource Acquisition, Allocation, Mobilization compliance between 46-71%
 - Support for out-of-area resources was only 36-50%
 - Demobilization was at 59-68%

COORDINATION OF PATIENT DISTRIBUTION AND MEDICAL EVACUATION

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Patient movement from Scene, except:
 - (4.1.1 c, d) Non-contact protocols (61%), non-medical vehicles for transport (50%)
- ✓ , except:
 - (4.1.2 a) Inter-facility agreements
 - (4.1.3 c) Notification from hospitals for independent transport arrangements (44%)

- Patient Transfer, Transport , and Evacuation guidelines compliance at 18-57%

COORDINATION WITH HOSPITAL INPATIENT AND EMERGENCY CARE PROVIDERS

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates >75% compliance with:

- ✓ Hospital Communications, Data, Status, Plans, and Support, except:
 - (5.1.1 b, c) Mobile Communications to non-response hospitals (61%), Comm. ability w/MHOAC & DOC (61%)
 - (5.3.1 c) Temporary triage/treatment sites outside hospital (70%)

COORDINATION WITH OUT OF HOSPITAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE PROVIDERS

- The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 39-50% compliance for Coordination with out-of-hospital providers

COORDINATION OF PRE-HOSPITAL EMERGENCY SERVICES

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ START Triage guidelines (100%)
 - Prehospital System Transformation (61-75 %)
 - Austere Medical Care at 36-52%

COORDINATION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF TEMPORARY FIELD TREATMENT SITES

- Coordination and Support for FTS at 20-36%
