PLANS, POLICIES, PROCEDURES

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ MHOAC policies/procedures, except:
 - ☐ (1.1.1 f, i) Resource Procurement/Allocation (70%), ID Resources within OA (73%)
- ✓ Training and Exercises, except:
 - ☐ (1.3.1 a, b, c) LEMSA personnel training (64%), refresher (57%), exercises (64%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- OA Med/Health Plans (48-68%)
- EOC/DOC operations (66-73%)
- System Start-up, DOC operations, Demobilization (50-68%)
- After Action Reports (70-82%)

ASSESSMENT OF IMMEDIATE MEDICAL/HEALTH NEEDS

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Notification and Activation, except:
 - ☐ (2.1.2 e) Comm. Failure reporting sites (70%)
- ✓ Information Sources, except:
 - ☐ (2.2.1 h, i) Residents (14%) and Other Sources (14%)
- ✓ All Information Elements and Data Reporting guidelines

COORDINATION OF DISASTER MEDICAL AND HEALTH RESOURCES

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Inventories, except:
 - ☐ (3.1.1 f,h,i) Supply Vendors (9%), Inventory Detail (9%), and Annual Updates (14%)
- ✓ All Resource Acquisition guidelines

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- Ambulance Contract language 0-25% compliance
- Resource Allocation, Mobilization, Support compliance between 30-41%
- Resource Tracking compliance was 57-70%
- Demobilization was at 57-82%

COORDINATION OF PATIENT DISTRIBUTION AND MEDICAL EVACUATION

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates no area with 75% or more compliance.

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- Patient distribution (30-52%)
- Patient Transfer, Transport, and Evacuation guidelines compliance at 18-57%

COORDINATION WITH HOSPITAL INPATIENT AND EMERGENCY CARE PROVIDERS

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates >75% compliance with:

- ✓ Hospital Communications, Data, Status, Plans, and Support, except:
 - (5.1.1 b) Mobile Communications to non-response hospitals (61%)
 - (5.2.1 b, c) LEMSA participates in training (52%), Local HICS Trainer (43%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- Hospital Support (23-68%)

COORDINATION WITH OUT OF HOSPITAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE PROVIDERS

- The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 31-59% compliance for Coordination with out-of-hospital providers

COORDINATION OF PRE-HOSPITAL EMERGENCY SERVICES
