## **PLANS, POLICIES, PROCEDURES**

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ All MHOAC guidelines
- ✓ OA Medical/Health Plans, except:
  - ☐ (1.1.2 d, k, l) Org/Agency Roles (73%) Volunteer Utilization (50%) Legal Citations (53%)
- ✓ EOC/DOC operations, and Start-up except:
  - ☐ (1.2.2 a) Equip/Supplies list (70%)
- ✓ Training and Exercises, except:
  - ☐ (1.3.1 b, c, e) LEMSA refresher (57%), exercises (64%), Periodic Alerts (64%)
- ✓ After Action Reports, except
  - ☐ AAR should be reviewed for trends (59%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- DOC operations, **Demobilization** (39-66%)

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Information Sources, except:
  - ☐ (2.2.1 b, c, d, h, i) 911 (59%), Law (61%), Fire/EMS (64%), Residents (57%) and Other Sources (57%)
- ✓ Information Elements and Data Reporting guidelines, except:
  - ☐ (2.2.2 d, e) Other Medical Facilities (57%), Provider capabilities (64%)
  - ☐ (2.2.3 b) Departmental Operations Center (61%)

## **COORDINATION OF DISASTER MEDICAL AND HEALTH RESOURCES**

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Inventories, except:
  - ☐ (3.1.1 f, h, i) **Supply Vendors** (9%), **Inventory Detail** (9%), and **Annual Updates** (14%)
- ✓ Resource Acquisition, Allocation, Mobilization, and Support, except:
  - ☐ (3.2.2 a, b) Allocation of Resources (55%), Management of Volunteers (70%)
  - ☐ (3.3.1 d) **Transportation & Security** (41%)
- ✓ Resource Tracking, except:
  - ☐ (3.4.1 g, h, j) Equip. Damage (59%), Est. Release Time (59%) , Disposition (59%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- **Ambulance Contract language** 52-73% compliance
- **Demobilization** was at 25-43%

## **COORDINATION OF PATIENT DISTRIBUTION AND MEDICAL EVACUATION**

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Patient movement from Scene, except:

- (4.1.1 a, d) Casualty Info to EOC/DOC (34%), non-medical vehicles for transport (66%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- Patient Transfer, Transport , and Evacuation guidelines compliance at 27-59%

#### **COORDINATION WITH HOSPITAL INPATIENT AND EMERGENCY CARE PROVIDERS**

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates >75% compliance with:

- ✓ Hospital Communications, Status, Plans, and Support, except:
  - (5.1.1 b, c) Mobile Comm.to non-response hospitals (61%) Comm. ability w/MHOAC & DOC/EOC (61%)
  - (5.2.1 b) Local HICS Trainer (64%)
  - (5.3.1 d) LEMSA promote/participate in yearly exercise (64%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- Hospital Data (34-36%)
- Support (23-68%)

#### **COORDINATION WITH OUT OF HOSPITAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE PROVIDERS**

- The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 31-59% compliance for Coordination with out-of-hospital providers

#### **COORDINATION OF PRE-HOSPITAL EMERGENCY SERVICES**

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates >75% compliance with:

- ✓ START Triage guidelines (100%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- Prehospital System Transformation (39-75 %)
- Austere Medical Care at 36-52%
