PLANS, POLICIES, PROCEDURES

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ All MHOAC guidelines
- ✓ Training and Exercises, except:
 - (1.3.1 a, b, c) LEMSA personnel training (39%), refresher (57%), exercises (64%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- OA Medical/Health Plans (11-32%)
- EOC/DOC operations (32-64%)
- Demobilization (11-29%)
- AAR (36-64%)

ASSESSMENT OF IMMEDIATE MEDICAL/HEALTH NEEDS

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Information Elements, except:
 - (2.2.2 d, f) Other Medical Facilities (67%), Hazards (71%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- Notification and Activation (18-43%)
- Information Sources (14-29%)
- Data Reporting guidelines (25-43%)

COORDINATION OF DISASTER MEDICAL AND HEALTH RESOURCES

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Ambulance Contract language, except:
 - (3.1.2 f, g) LEMSA report (29%), LEMSA funding assist (39%)
 - (3.2.2 a, b) Allocation of Resources (55%), Management of Volunteers (70%)
 - (3.3.1 d) Transportation & Security (41%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- Inventories (11-43%)
- Resource Acquisition, Allocation, Mobilization, Support, Tracking, and Demob (11-36%)

COORDINATION OF PATIENT DISTRIBUTION AND MEDICAL EVACUATION

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates 75% or more compliance with:

- ✓ Patient movement from Scene, except:
 - (4.1.1 b) Casualty Info to EOC/DOC (43%)

Areas that generally demonstrate less than 75% compliance include:

- Patient Transfer, Transport , and Evacuation guidelines compliance at 4-16%

COORDINATION WITH HOSPITAL INPATIENT AND EMERGENCY CARE PROVIDERS

The aggregate data for this region demonstrates >75% compliance with:

- ✓ Hospital Communications, Status, Plans, and Support, except:
 - (5.1.1 b, c) Mobile Comm.to non-response hospitals (57%), Comm. ability w/MHOAC & DOC/EOC (29%)
 - (5.2.1 c) Local HICS Trainer (43%)

COORDINATION WITH OUT OF HOSPITAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE PROVIDERS
